


# B.E.E. is an acronym for Bring Everything Everyday.



This 3-ring binder houses EVERYTHING students and parents need to keep up-to-date with what is going on at school.

Gone are the days of wrinkled papers and lost notes, newsletters, or calendars. No more searching the house to find paper in order to write a note to school. Everything you need is in one notebook!

BEE books are important! They help students to establish good organizational skills ----- skills that can carry on throughout their time in school.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Money and Notes Pouch</b></p>	<p>This pencil pouch will house notes “for the teacher” and notes “for parents” -- it is also an ideal place to put money for book orders, lunch, milk, and field trips.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>2-Pocket Folder</b></p>	<p>Newsletters, school notes, field trip permission slips, homework, and monthly calendars, will be placed the 2-pocket folder. The hands located on the folder’s pockets indicate if the paperwork is to be filled out and brought “RIGHT Back To School” or if it needs to be “LEFT At Home.”</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Homework Pouch</b></p>	<p>From time to time, your child will take a book home to read, or will need to complete homework. Homework items will be placed in the ziplock bag (top loading, see through). Books should be read several times during the week and returned on Mondays. New books will be given every Tuesday.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Contacts Sticker</b></p>	<p>Ways to contact me and other staff members will be shared on the contacts page. Please keep the contact’s page in the Bee book. It will be updated, if necessary, during the course of the year.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Kindergarten ABC’s</b></p>	<p>Everything you and your child need to know about Kindergarten! Please read carefully and reference as needed throughout the year.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Class List and Schedule</b></p>	<p>A class list and schedule will be kept in a plastic sheet protector for you to reference, when needed. Our specialists, lunch, and recess times are indicated on the schedule.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ABC Chart and Star Words</b></p>	<p>Everyday your child will participate in our shared reading of the alphabet chart. Your child will also learn many high frequency words in Kindergarten. We call these words “Star Words.” An ABC Chart and listing of Star Words is included in the BEE book for review at home.</p> <p> At-home practice is highly beneficial (and recommended).</p>
